Junior Master Gardener

Junior Master Gardener camp (JMG) is a youth gardening program where we develop an appreciation of the natural world and cultivate the mind! The 2024 Wildlife Gardener Series will focus on integrating native plants in the garden and identifying and understanding forms of wildlife that may be encountered in garden habitat. We engage youth by combining life skills, gardening techniques, COOKING (nutrient dense food experiences), physical activity, and stewardship engagement. Gardeners can participate multiple years and grow their garden and nature knowledge. JMG connects with community, builds entrepreneurial skills by selling produce at the Lowell Farmer's Market, visits local farms and businesses to better understand Michigan's rich agricultural contributions, and develops stewardship and leadership skills helping care for the WWC gardens.

JMG Garden Gurus - A Level Up!

After participating in JMG for at least 1 season and meeting the age requirements, participants can continue to grow and learn in the WWC Gardens. Students will grow their own gardens that emphasizes sustainable horticulture practices. They will be in charge of their garden from planting to harvesting. Both groups meet on the same days and participate in the same outings.

In addition, they develop job and life skills such as responsibility, teamwork, communication, problem solving, and leadership. They will have the opportunities to successfully lead small groups. They will start to learn about farm management and develop garden and horticulture skills. They will help mentor new JMG members in the WWC gardens and model good stewardship, teamwork, and build community.

• JMG camp runs 8 weeks from 9:00-12:30 unless otherwise noted

May 30 (6:00-8:00 pm) June 13, 20, 25 (9:00-3:00 field trip), 27 July 11, 16, 18, 25, 30, August 1 (farmer's market day 9:00-2:00)

- Camp fee is \$275: includes materials, JMG hand book, t-shirt, and transportation for field trips.
- Registration and Deposit Due MAY 30! Please fill out one registration form for each camper. After May 30, sign-ups without deposit will open up to the waiting list.
- Cooking is part of most sessions and we work with honeybees, please make sure to fill out the ALLERGY portion of the registration.
- Campers will be responsible for bringing a snack each day camp meets.
- Camp size is a maximum of 16 students with a minimum of 8 students.
- Camp drop off begins at 8:50 am. Children are expected to be picked up no later than 12:40 pm.
- No camp the week of July 4th
- Your Child's Safety: We are serious about maintaining a safe learning environment for your child. All program instructors are either employees of Lowell Area Schools or volunteers and have participated in criminal background and driving record checks. Activities involve working on uneven surfaces, bending, twisting and walking outdoors. Persons with limited mobility and sensitivity to the sun and heat should consider these factors. If individualized attention is needed for campers with special needs, please contact Courtney Cheers to discuss options.
- Most of camp days will take place outside. Please dress for the weather and plan to be outside—layers are recommended!
- Cancellations: Camps will be held with a minimum of 8 students and a maximum of 16. Cancellations with a full refund will be taken up until June 5, 2024. After this date, cancellations will be charged a \$40.00 fee. Cancellation fees will be automatically deducted from any due refund. Parents will be notified by May 30, 2024 if a camp will be cancelled due to low registration. If this occurs, full refunds will be issued.
