- JMN camp—Audubon Adventures — Wednesdays, June 12, 19, 26 from 9am—12:30pm.
- **Camp fee is \$100:** includes materials & t-shirt
- **Registration and Deposit Due May 30!** Please fill out one registration form for each camper. After May 30, sign-ups without deposit will open up to the waiting list.
- Camp size is a maximum of 12 students with a minimum of 6 students in each age group
- Camp drop off begins at 8:50 am. Children are expected to be picked up no later than 12:40 pm.
- Campers will be responsible for bringing a snack each day camp meets.
- **Your Child's Safety:** We are serious about maintaining a safe learning environment for your child. All program instructors are either employees of Lowell Area Schools or volunteers and have participated in criminal background and driving record checks. Activities involve working on uneven surfaces, bending, twisting and walking outdoors. Persons with limited mobility and sensitivity to the sun and heat should consider these factors. If individualized attention is needed for campers with special needs, please contact Courtney Cheers to discuss options.
- Most of camp days will take place outside. Please dress for the weather and plan to be outside—layers are recommended!
- **Cancellations:** Camps will be held with a minimum of 6 students and a maximum of 12 for Audubon Adventures. Cancellations with a full refund will be taken up until June 5, 2024. After this date, cancellations will be charged a \$40.00 fee. Cancellation fees will be automatically deducted from any due refund. Parents will be notified by June 5, 2023 if a camp will be cancelled due to low registration. If this occurs, full refunds will be issued.
