2024 BOND PROPOSAL NO TAX RATE INCREASE

ESTIMATED FROM THE CURRENT DEBT MILLAGE RATE

On May 7, our community will be asked to consider a bond proposal for \$104 million to fund facility improvements throughout the District. If approved, **NO TAX RATE INCREASE** is expected from the current debt millage rate for property owners in the LAS District. Potential projects that would be funded by this bond include:



MODERNIZE LEARNING SPACES

- Transformation of Cherry Creek Elementary to separate existing shared classrooms
- Renovations to Lowell High School and expansion to the arts wing
- Equip learning environments across the district with:
 - Flexible furniture
 - Integrated technology
 - Small group and project-based learning spaces

IMPROVE FINE ARTS ATHLETICS, & COMMUNITY SPACES

- Renovate and expand the High School arts wing
- Construct an auxiliary gymnasium to provide additional practice space
- Replace our aging track
- Update the TOTS program space, Unity High School, and Wittenbach Center

UPDATE INFRASTRUCTURE

- Replace systems at the end of their useful cycle:
 - Upgrade mechanical, electrical, and plumbing systems
 - Replace roofing, parking lots, and sidewalks
- Update electrical infrastructure to support increased technology use
- Replace playground equipment at each elementary
